# Frequently Asked Questions About Giving

#### How much do I give?

Our gifts are just that—gifts. We encourage you to pray about this, to think not about dollars but about a percent of your income you want to share with God. What you decide is between you and Christ. Some people find it helps to plan giving as part of a regular monthly budget.

## What is a pledge?

A pledge is an estimate of how much FLC members and friends intend and hope to give to mission and ministry. They write the estimate on a pledge card and return the card to the church. While the primary pledge season is during the fall, pledges can be made or changed at any time during the year.

## Why is a pledge important?

Because the church's annual Mission and Ministry Plan reflects our priorities. When members tell us what they expect to give, we can plan mission and ministry.

# What if I have a financial problem and cannot meet my pledge?

Simple. Just contact Janice Eberenz, Director, Administration Ministries, in the church office and let her know that your circumstances have changed and that you need to change your pledge.

#### How do I actually give my money?

Most people write checks. Others give online through our website. Some have their bank accounts drafted. Some give stock. A few even give cash in an envelope with their name on it!

#### Thank you for pledging.

While church leaders and/or pastors will thank you for pledging, only Janice Eberenz knows the amount you pledge.
